

Obtaining support

Polish Investment Zone (previously Special Economic Zones)

- strategic consulting, comprehensive risk identification, identification of opportunities, threats and benefits and co-creation of an optimal action plan;
- verification of the possibility of obtaining by the investor a decision on support, in the context of proper determination of investment type, scope of exempted activity and meeting by the investment project the required qualitative and quantitative criteria;
- verification of key requirements resulting from EU regulations (e.g. ban on relocation of activities, fulfilment of the incentive effect, etc.);
- verification of the status (large entrepreneur or SME, considering EU requirements and possible exemptions);
- comprehensive advice in the procedure for issuing a decision on support, including preparation of the application and other documentation;
- support in direct, individual negotiations with the administrator, for both greenfield and brownfield investments;
- advisory services aimed at effective use of aid (adequately flexible description of the investment).

Real estate tax exemption


Supervision of state aid granted - grants

Expenditure compliance

- ongoing advisory on the regulation of the financial policy of the European Union, the Public Finance Act, public procurement law and other relevant provisions
- development of optimal purchasing procedures (competitiveness principle, market intelligence, etc.)

Ongoing duties

- support in preparing reports to ministries,
 NCBiR (National Centre of Research and
 Development) and monitoring of current project
 progress
- preparation of payment applications from the Managing / Intermediate Institutions (financing)



Audits of state aid granted

- assessment of the legal nature of the support obtained and then verification of the correctness of performance by the beneficiary of his legal and tax obligations
- verification of the legality of ad hoc state aid granted to the research institute
- giving opinions on issues related to the financial and material implementation of investment and research and development projects financed from public funds

Support in organizing tenders

 comprehensive support in the preparation of tenders for construction works, supplies and services within the framework of co-financed projects



Cooperation with administrative authorities

Relations with representatives of national authorities resulting from joint successful implementation of numerous, often difficult projects, as part of our advisory services, we provide assistance in negotiations and meetings with representatives of government administration, local government units, intermediary institutions such as ministries, the Polish Investment and Trade Agency, the National Centre for Research and Development, the Polish Development Found, the Area (Zones) Administrator or the Office of Competition and Consumer Protection (the body responsible for monitoring state aid).

Comprehensive support of aid beneficiaries during their control proceedings, both from national authorities (including the Ministry, NCBiR and NIK – Supreme Audit Office) and EU bodies (EC inspections):

- preparation of documentation before controls,
- assistance during control activities.

Representation in administrative and judicial proceedings

(including before the Provincial Administrative Court and the Supreme Administrative Court), regarding disputes concerning:

- obtaining state aid,
- extension of permits issued before 2001,
- changes, expiry, withdrawal of aid decisions,
- appeals against decisions of control bodies,
- complaints about tax interpretations that are negative for aid recipients.

Obtaining individual tax interpretations on behalf of beneficiaries on aid issues causing divergences in practice.



Other tax aspects in zone operations



Transfer prices in zone operations

Verification of the marketability of transactions concluded by SEZ entities with related entities, taking into account the specificity of SEZ activities, analysis of transfer prices (including benchmarks), certification of transactions (which is the basis for signing the TP statement by the management board), preparation of comprehensive transfer pricing documentation, preparation of transfer pricing policies, assistance in preparing and submitting transfer pricing information (TP-R) by SEZ entities.



Limit of (zonal and non-zonal) intangible costs and costs of debt financing

Analysis of transactions made by the zone entities in terms of the limit for including expenses for certain intangible services as tax deductible costs (Article 15e of CIT Act) and the limit for debt financing costs (Article 15c of CIT Act), preparation of tax interpretations in this respect, support in obtaining APA decisions.



Tax schemes and state aid

Verification of arrangements made by the zone entities in terms of the obligation to report tax schemes (MDR), preparation of an internal procedure for counteracting a failure to comply with the obligation to provide information on tax schemes, internal training on MDR regulations, with particular emphasis on the specificity of zone entities.

Selected key projects

Over PLN 112.87 million of support for an investment worth over PLN 1.5 billion consisting in the construction of a modern plant for the production of components for electric cars.

Negotiations with the Polish government for funding under the Program for Supporting Investments of Major Importance for the Polish Economy; support under the RET and CIT exemptions; support in the purchase of 70 ha of real estate in a tender organized by one of the municipalities, including conducting a legal analysis of the real estate.

Obtaining almost **one hundred zone permits and decisions on support**, including **over PLN 1 billion of support** for entrepreneurs in the form of a tax exemption within the Polish Investment Zone.


